



## Mark 6:14-16

<sup>14</sup> King Herod heard, for *Yeshua's* (Jesus') name had become known. Some were saying, "John the Immerser has risen from the dead! Because of this, these powers are at work in Him!" <sup>15</sup> But others were saying, "It's Elijah!" Still others were saying, "It's a prophet, like one of the prophets of old."<sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>16</sup> But when Herod heard, he said, "John, the one I beheaded, has been raised!"

King Herod had John the Baptist beheaded because John had warned him that taking his brother's wife as his own wife was sin. John was calling King Herod to repent. After King Herod had John the Baptist beheaded; behold, another comes along preaching and teaching the same message of repentance. Jesus preached the message with authority and multiplied his message through the 12 disciples sending them out 2 by 2. (Mark 6:7)

The message of repentance multiplied under the authority of Jesus, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. (Mark 6:12)
