1 Peter 3

Q.) Should we submit to our husbands?

A.) Yes.

Q.) Why?

Answer found in Vs. 2:

A.) So that even if some do not obey the order, they may be won over to Christ by the wives pure and reverent conduct without having to say a word.

Vs. 3

Q.) Should our beauty be external?

A.) No.

Q.) Why?

A.) Because what is precious in God's sight is a gentle and quiet spirit.

Vs. 5

Q.) What is a Holy Woman and how did they put on beauty according to God?

A.) The holy women who lived long-ago put-on beauty by hoping in God and submitting themselves to their own husbands.

Vs. 6

Q.) What is an example of this?

A.) Sarah obeying Abraham and calling him Lord.

Q.) How do we become daughters of Sarah?

A.) By doing good and not fearing any intimidation.

Vs. 7

Q.) What should husbands do?

A.) Be understanding towards your own wives as EQUAL HEIRS OF THE GRACE OF LIFE. By doing this the Lord will hear your prayers. But if husbands (men) do not do this their prayers will be hindered.

Vs. 8 & 9

Q.) How do we receive a blessing?

A.) By giving a blessing to those who speak and do evil towards us. Maybe, cook for them, clean for them, or give them a book. Your suggestions:

Q.) How do we see good days?

A.) Keep your tongue from speaking evil curses such as profanity or gossip. Turn from evil and do good. Seek peace and pursue it. Assalamu Alaikum.

Vs. 12

Q.) Who are the eyes of God on?

A.) The Righteous

Q.) Whose prayers does the Lord hear?

A.) The Righteous

Q.) Who is God's face against?

A.) Those who do evil such as: gossip and slander, etc.

Q.) Have you ever heard this in church? Or/ does your church just teach that God is for everyone?

Q.) Who would want to harm you for doing good?

A.) Your answer:

Q.) Should you worry about threats that others give you for doing good?

A.) No. We should sanctify Jesus as the Lord of our hearts and give an answer for the hope that we have in Jesus so that your abuser shall be put to shame.

Q.) Who else suffered this persecution?

A.) Jesus

Q.) Why

A.) To bring you to God.

Vs. 22

Q.) Where is Jesus now?

A.) At the right hand of God.

Q.) Why?

Vs. 20

A.) For this answer we are going to backtrack just a bit.

Because, a long time ago, in the days of Noah God was waiting patiently for the people to repent. But they did not repent because they could not through the flesh reach perfection. So, God destroyed the sin that was on the Earth in those days by sending a flood bringing only 8 souls through.

But now in the current day and time God brought us the gift of repentance: Luke 24:46-47

So that, we could make a "Pledge of Good Conscience" to God. (The Freedom to repent. Go back to that lesson and watch it if you haven't.) God gave us a decision to repent and turn to God and turn away from sin. This happened through the death and resurrection of the Messiah, Yeshua, Jesus the Christ. Vs. 1

Q.) What attitude should we arm ourselves with?

Vs. 2

Q.) What did Jesus live for, and what should we live for?

A.) We should not live for human desires any longer but only God's will.

Vs. 3 & 4

Q.) What are worldly people surprised of when they see a christian?

A.) That we do not run with them in their riot of recklessness, such as:

Indecency, lusts, drunken binges, orgies, wild parties, and lawless idolatries.

Q.) What will worldly people do if you don't do the same things as them?

A.) They will vilify you.

Vs. 5

Q.) But what will happen to them?

A.) They will give an account to the one who stands ready to judge the living and the dead.

Vs. 6

Q.) Why was the Good News of the Gospel of Repentance taught?

A.) So that even though we are judged in the flesh before humans, we will be able to live in the Ruach before God. (The Holy Spirit).

Vs. 7

Q.) Is the end of all things near?

A.) Yes

Vs. 8

Q.) Why should we keep our love constant?

A.) Because love covers a lot of sin.

Vs. 9

Q.) Should we grumble?

A.) No. We should use our gift to serve on another.

Vs. 11

Q.) If we serve others, whose strength should it be with?

A.) The strength that God supplies.

Vs. 12

Q.) Should we be surprised at the fiery ordeal taking place among us to test us?

A.) No. We should rejoice because we are sharing in the sufferings of Messiah.

Vs. 14

Q.) What rests on us if we are insulted for the name of Jesus?

A.) The Spirit of Glory and of God rests on us.

Vs. 17

Q.) If judgement begins with us first what happens to those who outright disobey God's Word, the Gospel of Repentance?

Vs. 18

Q.) If it is hard and difficult for the righteous to be saved (and it is), what happens to the ungodly and the sinners?!

Vs. 19

Q.) So, then what should we do?

A.) Let them trust their souls to a faithful Creator while continuing to do good.
